The Embassy of the Federative Republic of Brazil presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Bosnia and Herzegovina and has the honor to inform it that the Brazilian Ministry of Industry, Foreign Trade and Services (MDIC), with the goal of improving the system of verification of origin of imported goods, has updated the procedures for declaration of origin for non-preferential trading sources.

2. The Declaration of Origin document is mandatory for imported goods subjected to trade defense measures (antidumping, countervailing and safeguard measures), and to like products originated from producers and countries not targeted by such trade defense measures. According to Administrative Ordinance SECEX nr. 23, published on July 14, 2011, certificates of origin issued by governmental and non-governmental entities from the country of provenance of the concerned products will no longer be accepted as proof of origin documentation. Instead of the previous practice, a specific form shall be filled and signed by the producer or exporter of the goods. The model of the new mandatory form is displayed at the Annex XXVI of Administrative Ordinance SECEX nr. 23/2011, and is attached hereto. The new Declaration of Origin form replaces, to all legal and administrative purposes, the documents which were formerly accepted by MDIC as non-preferential certificates of origin in operations of foreign trade directed to Brazil. In this context, the forwarding of samples of stamps and signatures by governmental and non-governmental entities is no longer necessary.

4. The Embassy of the Federative Republic of Brazil would kindly request the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to forward this information to the competent governmental authorities and relevant non-governmental entities in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

The Embassy of the Federative Republic of Brazil avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Bosnia and Herzegovina the assurances of its highest consideration.
